## *Sunday, May 16th joint-parishes' Holy Eucharist announced*

St. Stephen's, along with St. Christopher's, will join with St. Paul's-on-the-Plains Episcopal Church for the Holy Eucharist on Sunday, May 16, at 10:30 AM, at Hodges Community Center (42nd St and University Av). The occasion is the 100th anniversary of the founding of St. Paul's, the first Episcopal church in Lubbock and nearby areas. The outdoor service will be conducted adjacent the historic St. Paul's church located in the park surrounding the

community center. Worshipers are requested to bring their own outdoor seating and blankets for the event. Nursery care will be provided at the current St. Paul's building, 16th St and Av X. PLEASE NOTE: Morning services and Sunday school at St. Stephen's are cancelled on May 16. Parishioners are urged to attend the joint service in celebration with St. Paul's, the church that started St. Stephen's as a mission parish in 1958.
